Minutes

January 15th. 2019

Location Burlington Library.

The meeting was opened by the President Anthony Seager at 7:00 PM.

In attendance were a total of 17 club members, including two wives, along with the returning Treasurer Harlan Brown, and the secretary for 2019 Charles Smith.

Harlan gave the Treasurers report. Advising the the name change from Skagit to Banner Bank.

The cost for the Christmas dinner was paid by the attending members, in the sum of \$797.00. Present balance is \$3760, plus membership dues paid this evening by four members.

Charles has sent an email to all members reminding them of fees for club membership, AMA, and FAA .

Harlan, gave a report on excerpts from the AMA and the status of requirements that have been passed by the US Congress in 2018, along with further possible action coming in 2019, where we as RC pilots will be required to show proficancy within the scope of our hobby. The AMA magazine has been covering the recent changes in the last few years of the publications. Discussion within the club was the flying height restriction at our field, **that is 400 ft.**

Charles requested information about the origin of the club, and asked if there was a record of its history. He also stated that if he was going to continue as Secretary he would like this information. plus a list and timeline of what needs to be done and when. He knows that John E and Harlan have these tasks at their fingertips, but as Secretary he would like that information should they not be available.

Charles also asked, for information, from members of the club regarding:

1. The club's status with the regional and national AMA.
2. The club's status with the FAA, if required.
3. As members of Skagit RC, what is your status with the FAA and AMA?

Is your membership in those organizations current?

If not what are your renewal dates?

The above topics generated great discussion, advice and information.

The final events of the meeting, were show and tell presented, by Tony, Andrew, Bob, and John E.

Tony closed the meeting requesting, members to bring additional items/projects for show and tell to the next meeting.
